



Greetings and happy tax season!

As we are all home, trying to stay warm and healthy, many of you have taxes on your mind! Way to be on top of it! In this first week of receiving tax information we have noticed a few early trends and wanted to address them right away. Here are a few pointers and reminders as you begin to gather your tax information:

1. The emailed organizers were sent from our office administrator, Erin Roberts, officeadmin@hettickaccounting.com. If you did not receive yours, please check your junk email and, if you do not find it, shoot Erin an email and she will resend it.
2. When submitting your 2020 tax information to our office, please wait until you have **ALL** of your tax information before sending or dropping off. The trickle in approach is not efficient for any of us 😊
3. If you marked **yes** to question #46 on the Client Questionnaire, "Did you receive an economic impact payment?", **I need the actual amount you received for both payments.** The economic impact payment ("stimulus payment") is causing some confusion. There were two rounds of payments; the first payment was sent out in mid to late spring of 2020 and the second payment was sent out in January, 2021. **Both payments will be reconciled on your 2020 tax return.** If you do not have any record of how much you received, you can log into your IRS taxpayer account (if you have one) or go to the IRS website "Get My Economic Impact Payment" <https://www.irs.gov/coronavirus/get-my-payment> which gives you some limited information about your payments.
